



DIALOGUE's Final Dissemination Conference

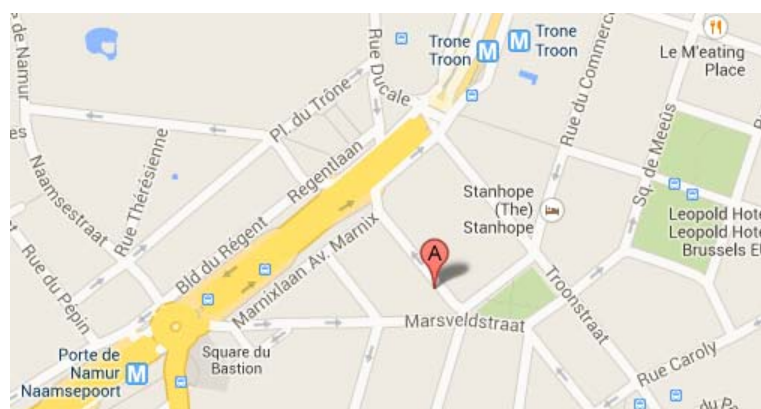
