# LLL Catalyst

- Governmental funding → public secondary & higher education
- Budget: €167m (2022/2023) + €225m (2024)
- Aim: contributing to economic growth by boosting LLL, in particular the role of educational institutes in LLL
- 4 work packages:
  1. Development of LLL 'radar'
  2. Boosting innovative LLL-activities
  3. Strengthening the organization of LLL in educational institutes
  4. Enhancing learning culture in organizations
- 2023 – 2025: WP2 and WP3 → 3 calls

# Experiences so far (WP2 & 3)

- More proposals for WP3 (organization) than WP2 (LLL activities)
- Positive:
  - A movement has started at all levels
  - A network and learning community is created

# Two important pillars

1. Collaboration: Systematic and dynamic co-creation
  - Educational institutes are not used to think outside-in
  - Often relatively new partnerships on LLL (shared vision and reciprocity)
  - Impact: thinking beyond the project is difficult
2. LLL-activities: integrating learning, working and innovation.
  - Accent on learning and on traditional LLL-activities
  - Research as an LLL-activity?
